Program presentation and objectives

The Skill Centers and Dedicated Player Program (SCDPP) is a new program for children **born in 2011 and 2010** who wish to **develop their soccer skills**. It will be supervised by youth educators and/or a certified technician with a minimum C License. **It is open to all but places are limited in order to keep the ratio of players per coach in line with Soccer Quebec requirements.
