SKILL CENTER and DEDICATED PLAYER PROGRAM (SCDPP)

Program presentation and objectives

The Skill Centers and Dedicated Player Programs is a new program for children **born in 2012 and 2013** who wish to **develop their soccer skills**. It will be supervised by educators, youth coaches and a certified technician with a minimum C License. **It is open to all but places are limited in order to keep the ratio of players per coach in line with Soccer Quebec requirements. The date of registration is the only criteria taken to access the program.** [Click here for more information.](#)

Program content

This program will begin the week of May 16 and end on Friday September 09, 2022. Players will have one or two practices per week and/or 1 LRSO game.) Sessions will be **organized as workshops on fields in the Aylmer area.**
